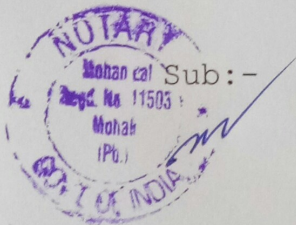

"Compulsory and Free Education for Children Act, 2009" Section 18 for the purposes of Recognition of your School under Free and Compulsory Education for the Children of Punjab Rule 2011, Rule 11, Sub-rule (4).

Ref.:- Memo No. 02/01-2020 Sepro(1)/37) dated Mohali, 15-01-2020 of Hon'ble D.P.I. (E.E.) Punjab.

Sir/Madam

In connection with the above said reference and upon your self-declaration recognize your Brookfield International School at village Sheikhpura, District S.A.S. Nagar upto 31.03.2023 from the First Class to Eight Class on the terms mentioned below :-

- 1) It is personal responsibility of the School Management that certificates to be submitted in this office regarding School Building Certificate and Fire Safety Certificate. In case of you fail then the process of de-recognition of your school will be initiated.

- 2) Recognition approval is not extendable and under no circumstances it is not applicable beyond the eight class/affiliation.
- 3) That the above recognition is based on self-declaration give by you. If any term of this form is found to be incorrect in your self-declaration then the process of de-recognition will be initiated.
- 4) The school is being run by a society registered under the Society Registration Act, 1860 (Act No. 21, 1960) or by a trust established under a law applicable from time to time.
- 5) If necessary, renewal of the Society's registration will be ensured.
- 6) The school is not being run for the personal benefit of any individual, group or individuals.
- 7) The school account will be audited and certified by a chartered accountant and appropriate statements of accounts will be prepared as per the rules.



- 8) The school will enroll 25 per cent of the total class in the first class, the children belonging to the weaker sections of the neighborhood and the disadvantaged group and will provide free and compulsory education till its completion. If the school provides pre-primary education, then the same conditions will be apply.
- 9) That for the children referred to in paragraph 7, the school will be reimbursed for the expenses as per provision 2 of section 12 of the Act. The school will need to have a separate bank account to receive this reimbursement.

- 10) The school will not charge any completion fee and will not involve the child or his/her parents or guardians in any selection process.
- 11) The school will not refuse admission to any child for the following reasons:
- a) No proof of age of any child
 - b) Asking for admission after the extended time by any child, or
 - c) Religion, caste, race or place of birth or any of these reasons.
- 12) Schools will ensure that-
- a) No enrolled child will be kept back in class or expelled from school before completing basic education.
 - b) No child was subjected to physical punishment or mental distress
 - c) The child will not be required to pass any board exam until completion of basic education.
 - d) Every child who completes elementary education will be given a certificate as per Rule 21.
 - e) Children with disabilities/special needs will be involved as per the provisions of the Act.
 - f) As per sub-rule (1) of section 23 of the Act, only teachers who meet the minimum educational qualifications will be appointed.
 - g) Teachers will not engage themselves in any private teaching activities.
13. The school will adopt the curriculum based on the subjects determined by the appropriate authority.
14. The school shall comply with the conditions and standards laid down under section 19 of the Act.
15. No unrecognized classes will be conducted inside or outside the school building under this school name.



16. School buildings or other structures or grounds will be used for teaching and capacity building only.
17. The school will provide the required information and knowledge to the Director School Education or District Education Officer from time to time and the State Government will follow the instructions issued by the local authority to maintain the affiliation of the school.
