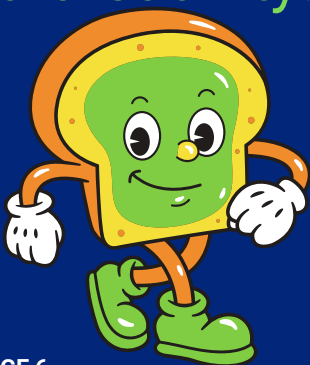
# SANDWICH MAKING ACTIVITY
